We're bringing the Banff Film Festival back to theaters, as we do every year! **The big European premiere will take place on 27 January 2025 in Munich** at the Alte Kongresshalle, featuring a program that takes bold new paths, paths that all are invited to explore.

In **A Team Sport**, **Courtney Dauwalter** demonstrates that while ultramarathons may be a battle against oneself, they are never truly done alone. Her incredible achievements are only possible with the support of her team. Climber **Molly Mitchell**, featured in **Dropping Molly**, has spent her life chasing adrenaline. After a climbing accident, she begins to question whether she's driving her passion for climbing or if it's actually controlling her.

The film **Farming Turns** explores the extent to which we should question ourselves and our connection to our sport. **Chris Rubens**, a former world-class freeride skier, reflects on the impact of global ski trips on climate change. He decides to take action—putting away his skis and becoming an organic farmer. Sustainability also takes center stage in **Going East**. A group of freeriders travels through Eastern Europe, seeking the best descents while using only public transport.

Following the German premiere in Munich, the Banff Centre Mountain Film Festival World Tour 2025 can be experienced at **more than 90 events across Europe**. In addition to **Germany, Austria, Switzerland, the Netherlands, Belgium, and Luxembourg**, this year's tour will make its debut in **Liechtenstein and Slovenia**. The 2025 tour program features five films. With moderation and an intermission, each event lasts between 2.5 and 3 hours.


